Dr Stanton currently holds an NHRMC Early Career Fellowship and has over 50 peer-reviewed publications. She recently won the Top 5 under 40 science communicators contest (ABC Radio National and UNSW) and the Ronald Dubner Research Prize for the best series of pain publications (International Association for the Study of Pain). Her research focusses on clinical pain neuroscience, with a specific interest in cortical body representation, somatosensation, multi-modal illusions, and pain.</p>

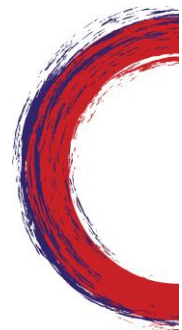
